



2007 Cotton Replant Program: Southwest

Participating Area: Texas, Oklahoma, New Mexico and Kansas

Growers who plant CROPLAN GENETICS® cotton seed varieties will get 100% assistance for seed replants utilizing CROPLAN GENETICS® cotton seed.

Program Eligibility

Eligible growers who plant at least the same quantity of CROPLAN GENETICS® varieties in 2007 as was planted in 2006 **OR** who plant a minimum of 20 bags of CROPLAN GENETICS® cotton seed are eligible for 100% assistance for replanted seed (germplasm only).

Offer Conditions

- Growers must make every attempt to utilize sound crop management practices to establish a stand to produce a crop.
- This program covers replants resulting from the eligible crop being destroyed by an act of God; limited to hail, wind and/or flooding events only.
- Loss of an early season stand of cotton due to cold temperatures, insects, diseases or soil crusting is **NOT** covered.
- All claims must be submitted by July 15, 2007. Replant claims issued after the July 15, 2007 deadline will not be processed and no credit will be given.
- This replant offer does not include Monsanto technology fees and/or premium seed treatments. Grower is responsible for contacting the appropriate local provider to obtain technology fee/seed treatment refunds.
- Action Pact or other program payments will not be applied to replant bags.
- Replant bags must be planted in the current crop year and in place of the lost crop on the farm for which the replant refund is claimed. If a grower elects not to replant to CROPLAN GENETICS® cotton seed then the grower is not eligible for the program.
- Issuance of replant seed is contingent upon approved claim and corresponding sales reported for the farm and is dependent on supply availability.
- This program applies to only the first replant of the season and does not cover multiple replant situations.

How to Make a Replant Claim

1. Grower contacts local Agrilience retailer or Land O'Lakes affiliated member Co-op to verify replant acres.
2. Retailer or Co-op contacts CROPLAN GENETICS® District Sales Manager (DSM) for replant procedures. CROPLAN GENETICS® DSM must verify eligibility **prior** to replanting
3. Retailer and CROPLAN GENETICS® DSM investigates and confirms grower's replant claim
4. Grower will be issued CROPLAN GENETICS® replant seed, per the acreage stated in the replant claim. CROPLAN GENETICS® replant seed is dependent on supply availability.
