Drought Relief Program for Seed Drop Zone E

To Qualify:

In the event of a drought, a grower whose cotton crop is lost or yields less than 150 lbs. of lint per land acre will qualify.

Grower Refund:

\$50.00 will be refunded for **Americot and NexGen B2RF**

\$36.00 will be refunded for **Americot and NexGen RF** cottons.

\$37.00 will be refunded for **NexGen RR** cottons.

The Drought Relief Program applies only to crop losses and/or specified yield reductions incurred **due to drought conditions**. Losses or yield reductions due to other conditions or perils such as diseases, pests, hail, etc., are not eligible for this offer.

Farmers should notify Americot of potential claim fields and acreage prior to harvest or by October 1, 2008 (whichever is earlier).

Deadline for submitting final claim under this program is January 15, 2009.
