## 2011 Drought Program

WEST TEXAS, NEW MEXICO, OKLAHOMA, KANSAS  
(Seed Drop Zone E ONLY)

---

**If due to drought, you harvest less than 150 pounds of lint per land acre, you will receive 50% of the suggested retail price of the Americot or NexGen brand cotton seed planted on the affected acres.**

---

### Program Conditions:

- The deadline to submit a potential claim under this program is **October 1, 2011**. (A potential claim includes: Grower Information, Farm Number, FSA 578, Affected Acres, Variety and Number of bags planted.)
- Americot or NexGen cotton seed must be purchased in 2011.
- You must notify Americot, Inc. of potential claim acres prior to harvest or by October 1, 2011 (whichever is earlier). Americot has the right to reject without settlement any potential claim notifications received after October 1, 2011.
- **Americot will inspect all potential claims while the crop is still in the field and has the right to reject without settlement any potential claim not inspected by an Americot sales representative.**
- Claim must include proof of purchase of Americot or NexGen brand cotton seed used to plant claimed acres.
- Claim must include Federal Crop Insurance documentation, which verifies drought as the reason for the claimed acres yielding less than 150 pounds of lint/acre or ASCS 503 and FSA 578.
- **Acres that have yield reduction attributable to hail, wind, blowing sand, flood, disease, pests, or any other reason are not eligible for settlement under this program.**
- The deadline to submit final claim documentation for this program is January 15, 2012.

### Claim Process:

- Contact your dealer of potential claim acres.
  - Dealer contacts Americot sales representative.
  - Americot sales representative verifies the growers claim.
  - Americot sales representative will complete claim, payment is contingent upon approval.
  - Settlement for seed will be issued via check made out to the dealer and grower and mailed to the dealer.
