**PHYTOGEN<sup>®</sup> AND WIDESTRIKE  
DROUGHT RELIEF PROGRAM**

**PHYTOGEN WILL REIMBURSE 50% OF THE SUGGESTED GROWER PRICE FOR COTTONSEED AND 100% OF THE COST OF THE WIDESTRIKE FOR FIELDS THAT EXPERIENCE DROUGHT RESULTING IN A LINT YIELD OF LESS THAN 150 POUNDS.**

**Eligible products covered:** PhytoGen cottonseed and WideStrike Insect protection bought in 2011 and planted in 2011

**Eligibility Area:** PhytoGen cottonseed planted in Texas, New Mexico, and Oklahoma

To qualify the following requirements must be met:

- If due to drought, you harvest less than 150 pounds of cotton lint yield per acre, PhytoGen will credit the retailer for 50% of the distributor list price of the cottonseed and 100% of the WideStrike insect protection for the units used in the acre impacted by drought.
- The credit will be for PhytoGen cottonseed and WideStrike only. You, the grower, will need to work with your retailer and Monsanto for any drought relief programs related to Roundup Ready or Roundup Ready Flex herbicide tolerance traits.
- Farmers must notify PhytoGen of potential claim fields and acreage prior to harvest. PhytoGen or the retailer will need to inspect all claimed acres while the crop is still in the field and further reserves the right to reject without settlement all claims for which potential claim notification was not received before harvest.
- Deadlines for submitting claims are December 1, 2011.
- Claims must include your WideStrike Technology Agreement Number proof of purchase of the PhytoGen cottonseed and WideStrike insect protection used to plant the acres impacted by drought.
- Claims must include Federal Crop Insurance documentation which verifies drought as the reason for the claimed acres yielding less than 150 lbs. per acre. Acres not harvested or that experience yield reductions attributable to wind, hail, flood, disease, pests, or any other reason(s) are not eligible for settlement under this program.
- Final claims may only be submitted by a Dow AgroSciences representative on a PhytoGen Drought Relief claim form. Claim forms and all supporting documentation must be submitted using the same name and WideStrike Technology Agreement number as when the seed was purchased. Incomplete claims will be rejected.
- This program covers only the final planting of the season.
