



2017 COASTAL REPLANT PROGRAM

Crop replant assistance is offered to aid farmers when products fail due to natural causes including flooding, frost, soil crusting, and bird or animal feeding.

PROGRAM ELIGIBILITY AND REQUIREMENTS

OFFER CONDITIONS

- Corn, Soybeans, Cotton and other Specialty Crops: Final claims submission is July 31, 2017.
- Fall-planted alfalfa claims must be submitted by May 15, 2017. Spring-planted alfalfa claims must be submitted by July 31, 2017 deadline.
- Claims will only be valid within 60 days of planting, or by May 15, 2017 for fall-seeded stands.
- Replant units are not eligible for other program payments.
- Replant units must be planted in the same crop year as the lost crop and in place of the lost crop on the farm for which the replant refund is claimed.
- Replant payment is contingent upon approved claims and corresponding sales reported for the farm.
- Monsanto reserves the right to audit dealer sales and replant claims at any time.
- Replant units will NOT qualify for base Apex® program compensation.
- Germplasm replant payments are calculated on the second crop planted and not the lost crop.
- Upstream treated seed: Acceleron® Seed Applied Solutions offerings. Products are provided at the same reimbursement rate as the seed to customer on replant if original purchase was treated with Acceleron® Seed Applied Solutions offerings. Must be equal treatment product. Includes Poncho®/VOTIVO®.
- Downstream treated seed: Refer to the 2017 Acceleron® Seed Applied Solutions pricing and programs for downstream treatment replant reimbursement.
- A Monsanto authorized representative, authorized retailer or seed supplier where purchase originated or approved designee must inspect and verify grower's seed loss, replant. A claim report must be filed for each claim.

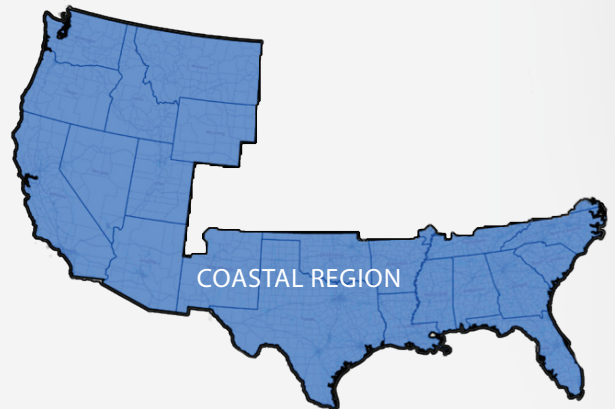

2017 COASTAL CROP LOSS AND DROUGHT RELIEF PROGRAM

(COTTON ONLY ZONE D & E)

Crop Loss Program Conditions

- Program valid only for the 2017 crop year in Monsanto's published Seed Drop Rate Zone D (which includes certain East Texas counties) and E (which includes the states of OK, NM, KS and certain West Texas counties). Please contact your local dealer to confirm geographical eligibility.
- Final submission for Crop Loss claims in Zone D is July 31, 2017, and for Zone E is August 14, 2017. Only Deltapine® varieties that are lost within 60 days of planting are eligible for Cotton Crop Loss.
- Stand reductions and/or yield loss after the first 60 days due to conditions or perils such as disease, pests, hail, etc shall not be covered under a Crop Loss claim.
- Verified cotton crop loss: Grower invoiced at 65% off the SRP
- Deltapine varieties DP 1044 B2RF and DP 1219 B2RF do not qualify.
- A Monsanto authorized representative, authorized retailer or seed supplier where purchase originated or approved designee must inspect and verify grower's seed loss, crop loss. A claim report must be filed for each claim.

Drought Relief Program Conditions

- Program valid only for the 2017 crop year in Monsanto's published Seed Drop Rate Zone D (which includes certain East Texas counties) and E (which includes the states of OK, NM, KS and certain West Texas counties). Please contact your local dealer to confirm geographical eligibility.
- Program applies only to crop losses and/or specified yield reductions on acres planted with qualifying Deltapine varieties and incurred due to drought conditions on certified dryland cotton acres. Deltapine varieties DP 1044 B2RF and DP 1219 B2RF do not qualify. Losses or reductions due to other conditions or perils, such as diseases, pests, hail, etc., are not eligible.
- Program benefits are limited to qualifying Deltapine varieties. Added seed treatment costs are not included.
- Final submission for Drought Relief in Zone D is November 6, 2017, and for Zone E is January 8, 2018.
- Payment is contingent upon approved claim and corresponding sales reported for the farm.
- Monsanto reserves the right to audit dealer sales and claims at any time.
- The cotton crop is considered a loss if the actual or estimated lint yield is less than 175 lbs. per land acre due to drought on certified dryland cotton acres. Grower must provide proof of Federal Crop Insurance claim of an estimated yield less than 175 lbs. of lint per land acre and drought is the primary cause contributing to 50% or greater of the claim damage under the Multiple Peril Crop Insurance coverage for the affected areas. Total eligible acres equal the grower's reported acres planted with Deltapine varieties.
- If crop planted to Deltapine cotton yields less than 175 pounds of lint per land acre due to drought, and the grower harvests the field and has documentation to verify harvest, grower will qualify for 75% of the suggested retail price of the Deltapine seed unit.
- If crop planted to Deltapine cotton is estimated to yield less than 175 pounds of lint per land acre due to drought, and the grower does not harvest the field, grower will qualify for 65% of the suggested retail price of the Deltapine seed unit.
